FISH FRIDAY

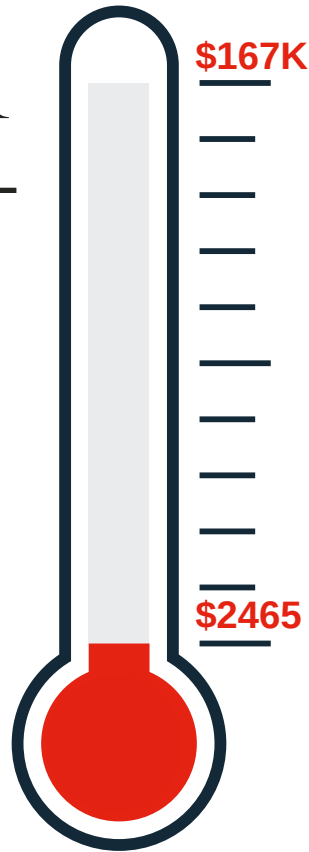
